Jurisdiction: The meeting will be held under the Rules and Standing Regulations for the BSMA/AMX, EASSC and the following supplementary regulations.

Entries: These are open to any rider holding a current licence issued by the BSMA/AMX. Day licences can be issued only on production of photographic evidence of authenticity.

Entry Fees: Open Group - £35.00 AMX Group - £35.00
Senior to Junior Groups - £30.00 Autos - £25.00
Day Licences £5 Transponder Hire £10

Please send stamped addressed envelope for confirmation and number.

Scrutineering: All machines will be scrutineered, together with helmet and clothing. All must comply with BSMA/AMX Standing Regulations. Riding numbers must be clearly displayed. The size and colour of numbers and backgrounds must conform to BSMA/AMX Standing Regulations. If a second machine is to be used it must be presented for scrutineering.

Riding Numbers: All numbers will be issued on a first come first served basis.

Start: A drop down type metal gate will be used. If the metal gate fails to work a Union Jack will be used.

Licences: Day Licence £5 All licences will be checked at signing on.

*Refunds will only be given on production of a doctor's note.
No later than the Monday before the race meeting*

Format of meeting:

Please note: The above times are approximate and may be altered at the discretion of the organising Club.

One single race result will be dropped from the total number of races run over the series.

Please note: Each rider is expected to be in the PARK FERME 5 minutes before the start of his/her race. Failure to do so will result in the exclusion of that rider.

Marshalling: If a marshal is not provided for the race meeting £10 must be paid

Please state on entry form if supplying a marshal

NOTE: NO CHILDREN OR PETS ARE ALLOWED ON MARSHALLING POINTS.

Paddocks/Car Parks: NO RIDING OF ANY MACHINES ALLOWED.

Engines must not be started until permission has been given.

Generators: Please turn all generators off by 11.00pm.

NO ATC's Quads, Motorised or Electric Bikes. DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEAD AT ALL TIMES WHENEVER RACING IS IN PROGRESS.

All competitors must have a minimum of 1.5kg Fire Extinguisher, type as dictated within Standing Regulations.

Race results will be decided by Transponder. Please indicate on entry form if you wish to hire one or have your own. If using your own please provide the number of the transponder on the entry form.

In the event of failure of electronic timing equipment the lap scores decision will be final.

Transponders can be purchased in advance from EASSC but please ring 07787544418 for availability.

Arbitration: In the event these Regulations are not fully explicit in any way, the Stewards will be final Arbiters.
